In addition to applying for an Adam's Camp scholarship, you may want to seek funding from other sources. Below is a list of *potential* resources to apply for. Adam's Camp does not endorse any of these organizations, and it is your responsibility to research and apply where appropriate.

Private Health Insurance: For our therapy programs we are happy to check for possible coverage for therapy services received. Please contact Susan Larson, 303-563-8290 ext. 17.

Agency Funding- Check with CCB Resource Coordinator to see if there is possible funding through family support monies, Medicaid waiver programs, or end of year funds.

United Healthcare Children's Foundation: For children 16 years or younger. Families must meet economic guidelines, reside in the US and be covered by a commercial health insurance policy. Grants up to \$5,000 for health care services not covered by commercial health insurance. <http://www.uhccf.org>.

National Autism Association- Helping Hand: For families of children with autism who are in financial crisis. US residents with a child on the autism spectrum, birth to 18.
